MAMILLA, a rock band from Zeeland (The Netherlands), is the most in his element live on stage.

The melodic compositions and sharp lyrics come mostly from singer Ruud Aerssens and guitar virtuoso Ricky V. The shows are tight, varied, dynamic and full of two- or three-voice guitar playing. MAMILLA's music is a mixture of classic, progressive and hard rock. With their style, the band has already built up a good reputation among the rock-loving public.

However, this did not go unnoticed by the international agencies. MAMILLA was therefore very proud and pleasantly surprised that in recent years they were asked to give support to world-famous rock bands with highlights: Deep Purple, Uriah Heep, ZZ Top, Whitesnake, Y&T, Wishbone Ash and Ten Years After.

Because of this, MAMILLA has had great experiences playing in the larger halls of the country, from a sold-out Afas live (formerly HMH) to a crowded IJsselhallen in Zwolle. The well-known halls in Zoetermeer, Alkmaar, Uden, Weert, Bergen op Zoom and Rotterdam are no longer strange to Mamilla.

On February 1, 1994 Ruud Aerssens, bassist Bas Matthijsse and guitarist Rick de Visser started the band MAMILLA PARADISE, but the band name was soon shortened to MAMILLA. In their 25 years of existence the band has undergone several band changes, but nowadays Ruud, Bas and Rick are still in the band and are still in the band.
